Cadetship Information

1. ENTRANCE QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicants must be between 16 and 20 years of age and have completed at least their third year of secondary education.

2. SELECTION:

In August/September all applicants will be advised whether or not they have been selected for a Cadetship.

3. CONDITIONS:

- a. Enrolment is for two years.
- b. Successful applicants must be physically fit, and have had anti-tetanus injections.
- c. The farm provides accommodation for 5 cadets. Rent is set at \$230 a fortnight for each cadet and will be deducted from their wages. This amount will be adjusted each year as recommended by the level of CPI.

4. EQUIPMENT:

Cadets are to provide the following equipment in addition to ordinary clothing:

- Suitable farm working clothes, including sunhats/beanies and thermals.
- Two pairs of boots – one pair lace up leather work boots and one pair gumboots. Steel capped safety boots will be provided by Jeff Farm.
- One full set of quality wet weather gear. Another set will be provided by Jeff Farm.
- Bedding and towels.
- Suitable killing knife and belt/pouch to carry it on.
- A 2-3 metre length of 10mm rope with a dog clip for pup training.
- Cadets are advised to insure and name their belongings.

5. OTHER

Cadets should apply for a community services card before starting their cadetship.

Cadets should have or be well on the way to having at least their restricted motor vehicle Driver's License.

6. PRIMARY ITO

All cadets must undertake the Primary ITO Courses (theoretical and practical training) assessed throughout their cadetship.

Jeff Farm will pay the Annual Primary ITO fees for the Courses, and an agreement is signed by the Manager and Cadets that if the Cadet fails to complete the course, payment will be reimbursed to the farm by the cadet.
